Checkout AudioBook

- OR
- Open **OneClickdigital MediaManager on your desktop** (if you have previously installed it)

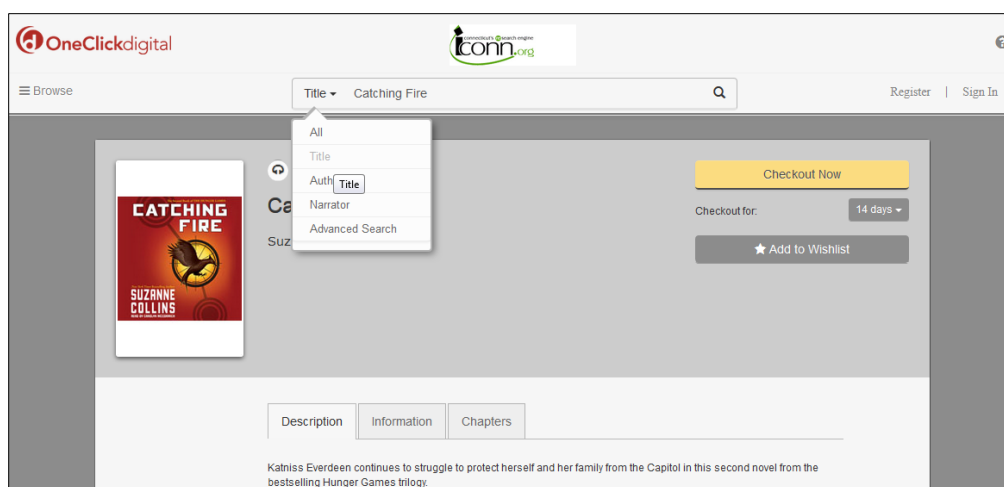
Sign in with your username

Type book title, author, etc into the Search field

Click the **Checkout Now!** button



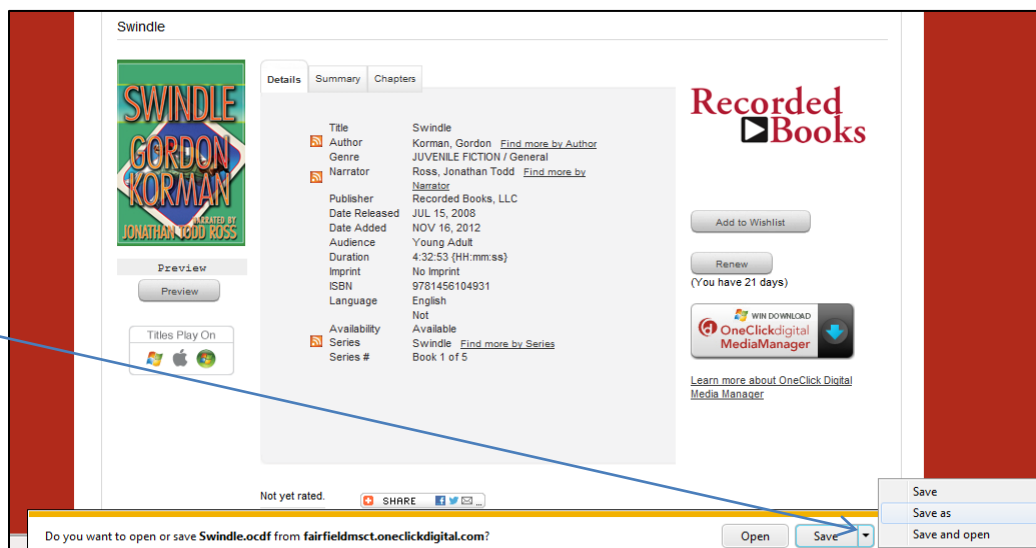
You may be prompted to Open or Save file.

Save AudioBook file




Listen to AudioBook using OneClick Media Manager
