

# Overdrive-----Borrow an eBook from FPS

## Sign in

There is no need to create an account. Accounts are already set up for you if you are a student or teacher in middle school or high school in the Fairfield Public Schools.

- Go to link: <http://overdrive.fairfieldschools.org/>
- Select Sign in near the top right of the screen
- In the Library box *select the drop down arrow*
- Select your school
- Type in your Library card number:
  - Student accounts: enter your 6 digit student ID
  - Teacher accounts: enter 00 (zero, zero) + your 4 digit ID
  - (If you are a teacher/staff member that does not have a class, ask your Librarian to set up your account)
- Select Sign in

You may browse without signing in.

## Borrow a book

- Once logged into OverDrive, search the collections to find a book you would like to borrow
- Click on the title
- Select the format you want
- Select Add to cart
- Select Proceed to Check Out
- Select Confirm Checkout
- If you have a Kindle, click on Get Kindle Book and log into Amazon to retrieve your book

**NOTE:** You must know your Amazon username and password to download the book to a kindle



The next time you use your Kindle, the eBook should be available to you.
